There are only about 40,000 elephants left in the entire Asian region. More than 15,000 of them in captivity under appalling conditions. To make them docile, their spirit must be broken.

This procedure is called PHAJAAN. Afterwards, they eke out a hopeless existence as riding and show elephants for tourists, as working elephants in the illegal timber industry, as begging elephants or they end up in forced breeding or are abused for religious purposes.

Jokia (f) - born about 1960
 ... worked in the illegal logging industry. While hauling trees, she gave birth to her baby, who rolled down the slope. But she was not allowed to help him. Her baby died. Jokia then went on strike and was blinded. In 08/1999 she was finally rescued.



Medo (f) - born about 1980
 ... continued to toil in the illegal logging industry with a broken ankle. When she was forced into a brutal breeding programme, she suffered severe injuries. Despite a broken knee joint and a dislocated hip, she has been enjoying her life in the ENP since 07/2006.



Noi Nah (f) - born about 1945
 ... spent almost 70 years in the hard elephant working world. Emaciated and blind in one eye, she was rescued from a trekking camp in 06/2015. Her rescue is documented in the film **"Loves & Bananas"**. She prefers to keep to herself.



Thai Koon(f)-born about 1960
 ... also worked in the illegal logging industry. She was still very young when she stepped on a landmine. Insane pain forced her to put weight on her left leg. Because of this, her leg deformed and she could hardly walk. In 2014, she was finally rescued.



Thong AE (f) - born.? ... had to work - separated from her mother - as a begging elephant already at the age of 1. When one of her nannies died, she suffered so much that her owner brought her to the ENP. And there she blossomed again. Unfortunately, her owner wants her back. With many sponsorships, she could be bought from him. Please help

Karen Elephant Serenity
 ... is home to a small herd that joined SEF's programme in 02/2018 and so **MAE KHAM SUK** (40 yrs) was able to give birth to her baby girl in freedom on 16 March 2019. **HENGHENG** is the lively girl's name, which means **"lots of luck"**.... In order for HENGHENG to stay with her family, donations are urgently needed.



SURIN - Project
 Lack of income has forced many mahouts from BAN THA KLANG to go begging with their elephants in big cities. Therefore, the **SURIN PROJECT** was launched in 2009. In this concept of sustainable salary, the weekly payment (along with other incentives) depends entirely on the continued welfare of their elephant. Another approach involves local community work, rescue and rehabilitation programmes, and educational ecotourism measures.
